Fire Chief's Report written by Acting Chief P. Haskell for 10 April 2025

Since our last meeting on 27 March the department has answered 133 calls for assistance. The department answered 342 calls in March.

I, Clerk Treasurer, and her staff met to discuss the new FMLA policy and some of the ideas and potential needs of the Fire Department that will differ from other District employees. Research is being conducted to answer and make additions.

On 31 March we brough the new recruits in for orientation. Captain Callinan led this. We had numerous members attend and welcome new members to the department.

1 April I, Asst Chief Rogers, Captains Bird and Callinan attended the annual Plymouth County Myles Standish Compact and Brush meeting at Carver Fire.

Asst Chief Rogers and FF Crabb met with Plymouth Fire Department to update our mutual aid agreements.

Dispatcher Geggatt was activated for EOC for the protest held on 5 April, no issues or incidents.

The department was awarded grants from the Department of Fire Services. One was for equipment and the total was \$4,854.32. The other was for SAFE and Senior SAFE which is for fire education and the total was \$7,200.00.

Adjusters report came in and not out of pocket expenses for the damage from the accident.

Four personnel, Brush Breaker and I attended live fire training at Joint Base Cape Cod 10 April for wildland firefighting.

The department is heading to the Boston Fire Academy this weekend for live structural fire training.
